Getting to Anguilla

From the U.S. & Canada

- Direct flights are available to Anguilla (AXA) from Miami (MIA).
- Direct flights are available to **St. Maarten (SXM)** from major U.S. and Canadian cities.
- From Miami (MIA), New York (JFK), Charlotte (CLT), and other hubs, airlines such as American Airlines, Delta, JetBlue, and United offer flights to SXM.
- From St. Maarten, travelers can take a ferry or a short flight to Anguilla.

From the U.K. & Europe

- Direct flights from London (LHR/LGW) to St. Maarten (SXM) are available with British Airways and other European carriers via connections in Paris (CDG) or Amsterdam (AMS).
- From St. Maarten, travelers can take a ferry or a short flight to Anguilla.

From St. Maarten to Anguilla

- Ferry Services: Public ferries run from Marigot (French side) to Anguilla's Blowing Point Ferry Terminal (approx. 25 minutes). Private ferry companies also offer luxury transfers from Simpson Bay and Princess Juliana International Airport (SXM).
- Flights: Anguilla Air Services offers short flights between SXM and Anguilla's Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport (AXA) (approx. 10 minutes).

*Please ensure you have the appropriate funds available for the departure tax when planning your travel from Anguilla. While Credit Card may be accepted, have cash on hand just in case.

Marigot Bay (French Side)

The **public ferry** operates eight (8) times daily between St. Martin and Anguilla. The regular one-way fare is US \$30 for person 12 years and older. Children under twelve years old are US \$20. **CASH ONLY**

- All persons traveling to and from Anguilla by ferry must clear Customs & Immigration at
- the Blowing Point Ferry Terminal.
- Advanced reservations for the public ferry are not available, therefore you should show up at least 30 minutes prior to departure.

ST. MAARTEN

Princess Juliana Int'l Airport (Dutch Side)

A number of private companies operate comfortable and professional ferry services from the Anguilla – St. Maarten Ferry Terminal located across from the Princess Juliana Airport. Fares start from US\$65 per person, one-way. Schedules are seasonal and operate from St. Maarten to Anguilla between the hours of approximately 9:00am and 5:00pm. From Anguilla to St. Maarten the ferries run from approximately 7:30am to 4:30pm.

- All persons traveling to and from Anguilla by ferry must clear Customs & Immigration at the Blowing Point Ferry Terminal.
- Departure tax can be paid in cash or by credit card.
- Reservations are advised; most operators offer online schedules and booking platforms. Private charters are also available.



Departing Anguilla

Travelers are required to pay a departure tax, the amount of which varies based on the mode of transportation, destination, and age of the traveler. Below is a breakdown of the departure taxes:

Departure via Ferry to St. Maarten (Dutch Side):

- Non-Residents Staying Over 12 Hours:
 - o Adults (12 years and older): US \$36
 - o Children (5-11 years): US \$23
 - o Children (2-4 years): US \$11
 - o Children (Under 2 years): US \$8
- Day Trippers and Residents of Anguilla & St. Maarten:
 - o Adults (12 years and older): US \$19
 - o Children (2-11 years): US \$11

Departure via Ferry to St. Martin (French Side):

- Non-Residents Staying Over 12 Hours:
 - o Adults (12 years and older): US \$28
 - o Children (5-11 years): US \$15
 - o Children (2-4 years): US \$3
- Day Trippers and Residents of Anguilla & St. Martin:
 - o Adults (12 years and older): US \$11
 - o Children (2-11 years): US \$3

Departure via Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport:

- Adults (12 years and older): US \$28

Mastercard and Visa are widely accepted in restaurants and bars. American Express is limited.

Tipping

When <u>dining</u>, the bill usually includes 15% service charge (to be shared among the staff) and 13% government tax.

It is your choice to tip up to 20% for exceptional service or leave extra cash (\$2-\$5) that will go directly to your server.
